#### PLANNED SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

#### 1. LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- 1 Acquire scientific, technical, cultural and human knowledge about the maintenance of children's health and about diseases that affect them throughout their pediatric lifecycle.
- 2- Describe the physiopathology, signs, symptoms, study and treatment methods of different diseases that hit the child throughout the pediatric lifecycle.
- 3- Identify situations of health and illness in case of the appearance of clinical cases.
- 4- Understand how the disease affects the children and family.
- 5- Development of clinical skills of appreciation, diagnosis, outcome and evaluation of the treatment, according to the process methodology of nursing, in the three levels of prevention and the conceptual model of Virgínia Henderson.
- 6- Development of an active part and regulator of it's apprenticeship.
- It is expected that the student acquires the following skills: 1- To know the evolution of child's health and pediatric nursing and child care. 2- To design and plan, in a theoretically substantiated manner, an evaluation plan of the child's needs. 3-To use a verbal language, according to the nomenclature of basic human needs, to judge, diagnose and implement nursing care to children /family. 4- To use, in practical cases, logic that allow to correlate and substantiate the nursing interventions more suitable. 5- To conduct research in technical literature, specialty and in international databases of evidence-based medicine. 6- This set of skills is intended to contribute to the gradual development of the nurse's skills profile of general care defined by the Order of Nurses.

### 5. TEACHING METHODOLOGIES (INCLUDING EVALUATION)

Face-to-face or synchronous and asynchronous classes by videoconference through the videoconf-colibri.zoom.us platform, if a contingency plan is established, with an expository and participatory method, stimulating the critical and reflective thinking of students to acquire theoretical knowledge and understand the problem of health, illness and hospitalization in the life of the child, adolescent and family and relating them to the practice of nursing in the different contexts of care provision. Resolution of practical exercises in clinical practice situations.

The evaluation will be periodic and final and the classification is made on a scale of zero to twenty values

- Periodic evaluation:
- Group work with individual presentation and discussion 30%, Valid for two academic years.
- 1 Written assessment tests, individual 70%.

It is mandatory to fulfill all the moments of the periodic evaluation.

The final evaluation will result in the completion of an exam, either in the normal exam period or in the appeal period, when the classification obtained in the periodic evaluation is less than 95 values and the student meets the criteria for be able to accomplish.

The final classification of the UC is the sum of the periodic evaluation taking into account the respective percentages or the classification of the final evaluation when there was no approval in the first.

For ERASMUS mobility students, exceptionally, the form of assessment can be agreed with the student.

#### 6. COHERENCE BETWEEN TEACHING METHODOLOGIES AND OBJECTIVES

Classes with an expository and participatory method, stimulating the critical and reflective thinking of students to acquire theoretical knowledge and understand the problem of health, illness and hospitalization in the life of children, adolescents and families and relating them to the practice of nursing in the different contexts of supply of care. Group dynamics and resolution of exercises / cases for discussion of topics and resolution of situations presented.

Guidance tutorial to guide and monitor group work and clarify doubts that promote research and responsibility for learning.

#### 7. ATTENDANCE

The hours of theoretical-practical and practical contact are mandatory, the absence limit being 25% of the number of hours allocated in the study plan. Thus, the student may be absent for up to 4,5 hours. The evaluation contact hours are mandatory.
